Red Ant Pants star

Like a lot of young businesses, Red Ant Pants doesn't have a big marketing budget.

The White Sulphur Springsbased company sells work wear designed for women. Sarah Calhoun founded the company about a year and an half ago.

When a friend with film experience offered to help her create a commercial, Calhoun originally planned to post it on her Web site.

Then someone suggested that she try YouTube, the online usersubmitted video site.

The commercial went up early last week and Calhoun soon learned the reach of the Internet.

"We had 1,500 hits and it was not even up a week yet," she said. "I'm not very hip on YouTube, but the feedback we've received already is tremendous." Calhoun's filmmaking friend is Cindy Stillwell of the Montana State University-Bozeman film department.

The actors were recruited friends who volunteered.

"We filmed from sunup to sundown on a pretty limited budget," she said.

The two-minute humorous commercial opens with a scene of two guys and a pickup that's stuck off the road. Three women stop to help, but neither party has a chain for a tow. The solution is a pair of Red Ant Pants.
